

Marsh View Meadows Park, located within the 535 acre Pittsfield Preserve, was the initial park improvement project undertaken after Pittsfield Township's historic purchase of this important property.

Completed in 2006, the park features an approximate 45 acre nature area with over two miles of accessible trails, interpretive signage, and wetland observation decks and boardwalks. Constructed, in part, with funding from a Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund grant, the park also includes restrooms, a picnicking area with a covered pavilion, playground structures, and open field play areas.

The Johnson Hill Land Ethics Studio prepared all grant application materials, developed the master plan for the park, prepared first phase construction documents, and performed construction observation for the initial phase of construction.



Providing ADA compliant trails to all areas of the park proved particularly difficult due to the extreme topographical relief present on the site. Working closely in the field with Township representatives, trail routes were identified that resulted in minimal site disturbance while at the same time providing barrier-free access to all naturally significant areas of the park.
